*Q&A with Guitar Icon Navarro and Director Newman, Moderated by  
Renowned Publisher Judith Regan and Fast Company's KC Ifeanyi  
Immediately Following the Screening*

**Beverly Hills, CA—October 29, 2018** — The inaugural Infinity Film Festival (IFF) will feature a special screening event of **Dave Navarro** Presents *Mourning Son*, a film by **Todd Newman**, on Sunday, November 4. The documentary, which tells the tragic story of Navarro's mother's murder, will screen at RealD Theater at 100 North Crescent Drive in Beverly Hills at 4:30 p.m. PT. Immediately following, there will be a question-and-answer session with Navarro and director Newman, to be moderated by media personality Judith Regan and KC Ifeanyi of Fast Company.

In *Mourning Son*, the Jane's Addiction guitarist opens up about the tragic murder of Constance Navarro, and her friend, Sue Jory, who were brutally murdered on March 3, 1983, by Constance's ex-boyfriend, John Riccardi. For eight years the killer eluded capture while Navarro dealt with his trauma and fear through drugs, art and escapism. *Mourning Son* focuses on the true story of what really happened to Navarro's mother and the repercussions of her death. The film was written by Navarro and director Newman, and was produced by Navarro, Newman and Larissa Swan.

“This was a subject matter that was very close to our hearts and needed to be told just right – ultimately taking seven years to make,” said Newman. “Through *Mourning Son*, Dave was finally able to find a vehicle to open up about the tragedy that occurred to him when he was 15. We are honored to screen this film at IFF and hope it will continue to open lines of communication for those who have endured painful situations.”

In addition to the *Mourning Son* special screening event on the final day of the IFF, festivalgoers will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in other programming including the HULU sneak preview of *Zen Dog* and the behind-the-scenes short *Zen Dog: On the Road* at the Laemmle Music Hall (includes Q&A session with director Rick Darge and producer Chadwick Dunn); CW presents *All American* (Q&A session with actors Michael Evans Bahling and Daniel Ezra, producer/writer Nkechi O'Carroll and moderated by Fast Company's KC Ifeanyi) and EPIX presents *Berlin Station* (Q&A session with actor/director/writer Leland Orser and writer/producer Jason Horwitch, moderated by Fast Company's KC Ifeanyi) both at the Writers Guild Theater. The IFF will also be featuring the world premiere of The Chemical Era VR Experience from Veronica Flint at the Writers Guild Theater.

“We are so excited to have *Mourning Son* screen at IFF,” said co-founder Mark Lieber. “This is a very personal story that Dave and Todd have put on the big screen and we know that the Q&A with Judith Regan and KC Ifeanyi will be very compelling.”
